### Fall 2015

As of mid-October, there are about 743 members in the South Central Section. Of that number, approximately 73 are Student Pilot members and 32 are At-Large members. We have 25 chapters.

The *Approach*, *99 News*, and our Section Facebook page (SCS 99s) are good sources of information for seeing what other chapters and members are doing. Be sure to post meetings, events, member flying/training milestones, etc. on the Section Facebook page (such as fundraisers, FAA safety meetings, etc.). Some social is okay, but be careful. Elizabeth Frankowski is the Facebook page administrator. Back issues of the *Approach* are on the Section website under "Publications"; no log-in is required. Back issues of *99 News* are on The 99s' website (no log-in required) under "About the Organization".

2015-2016 paper membership directories can now be pre-ordered by contacting Headquarters at 800-994-1929. Copies are \$15 plus postage/handling. The directory is also available as a CD at \$5 plus postage/handling. It can be found on The 99s' website in the 'Members Area' where it is updated on a weekly basis. Log-in on the home page with your email address on record with HQ and then your password. If you need a password, there is a link on the home page to get one from HQ. There is no charge for the online directory. Past years' directories are also archived in the 'Members Area'. Remember the membership directory is a private membership listing and cannot be used for political or commercial purposes.

AOPA had a fly-in September 26 at Colorado Springs, CO. There are no 2016 fly-ins scheduled in our Section.

Remember the *Approach Lite* will be emailed – following the Section meeting - to each member with an email address. This provides highlights from our meeting; watch for it in your email. It will also be posted on the SCS website. If you have Chapter members who do not have email or Internet access, this is a great way to connect with them and pass on the information.

Don't forget the quarterly webinars on a wide variety of topics. These can be viewed live via registering or at a later date. Next one is this coming Monday, October 19, on 'Setting Up a Chapter Website'. The final webinar for the year is December 7, 'Fundraising Ideas for Chapters'.
